

HOW TO INSTALL YOUR ROMAN BLINDS



POSITION THE BRACKETS

Position the brackets 10 cm in from each side.



FIT THE BRACKETS

The arrow on the Roman blind bracket must always point upwards, regardless of whether you are fitting the brackets to the ceiling or the wall.

FIT THE ROMAN BLIND



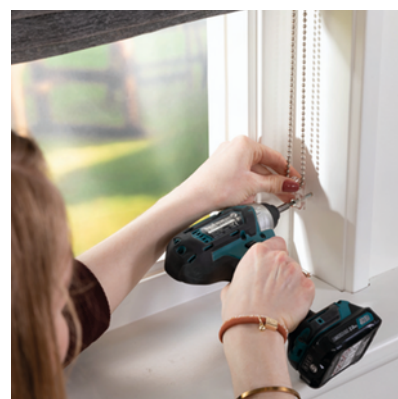
POSITION THE HEADRAIL

Place the bottom edge of the back of the headrail into the brackets, with the headrail tilted slightly forwards.



CLICK THE HEADRAIL INTO PLACE

Then push the entire headrail backwards until it clicks securely into all the brackets.



SECURE THE CHAIN (OPTIONAL)

Where possible, secure the chain to the wall using the supplied chain guide to keep the chain safely out of reach of children and pets.

ALLOW THE ROMAN BLIND TO SETTLE

Use a handheld steamer or a steam iron to remove any creases from the Roman blind.

Leave the Roman blind hanging for a few days to allow the fabric to settle and achieve the best result.
